What is Enable Works:

ENABLE Works' All in Highland Project is supported by Highland Council and European Social Fund to provide a personalised support service for people with Additional Support Needs, aged 16+ and based in the Highlands, to help find and keep a paid job. Our support is personal to you – we will work with you to meet your needs.

We will support you to find a job that you want to do. We can support you to find job vacancies that suit you. We can support you with job applications and preparing for interviews.

When you get a job, we can support you and your employer to make any changes you need at your workplace. We can give you job coaching in work to help you do your job well – and keep it. We can also give you advice about money and benefits. And we can tell you about other services in the Highlands who may be able to support you as well.

Who can apply?

Our opportunities are open to anyone aged 16+ with an additional support need who lives in Highland. If you are still at school but leaving shortly please get in touch if you want to find out more about our programmes. The programme is on-going, so you can apply at anytime.
