Energy pricing update – January 2023


This is a quick price update to the one we drafted in October which is still available on the Energy Advice pages of our website. We are now three months into the initial Energy Price Guarantee period. Originally the plan was for an unchanged energy price guarantee until Spring 2024. Now however prices have altered for some tariffs this January (particularly credit THTC) and the Guarantee costs will go up again in April 2023. These two graphics show the long term trends of single rate and THTC tariffs.

This graphic illustrates energy price escalation over the last six years – it shows an SSE single rate tariff for the purchase of 10000 units. The rate fell very slightly this month.

Over 60% of LSHA tenants still buy their electricity from SSE – the following table shows the price increases for their main tariffs from last winter to this winter. Despite the Energy Price Guarantee rates have risen significantly in a year. This trend is replicated by all energy companies.

In April 2023 the overall Energy Price Guarantee is expected to be raised by another £500 a year. The Government will continue to offer means tested support to benefit claimants and pensioners but the universal £400 payments will stop – the last £66/£67 a month payment for all will be in March 2023.
