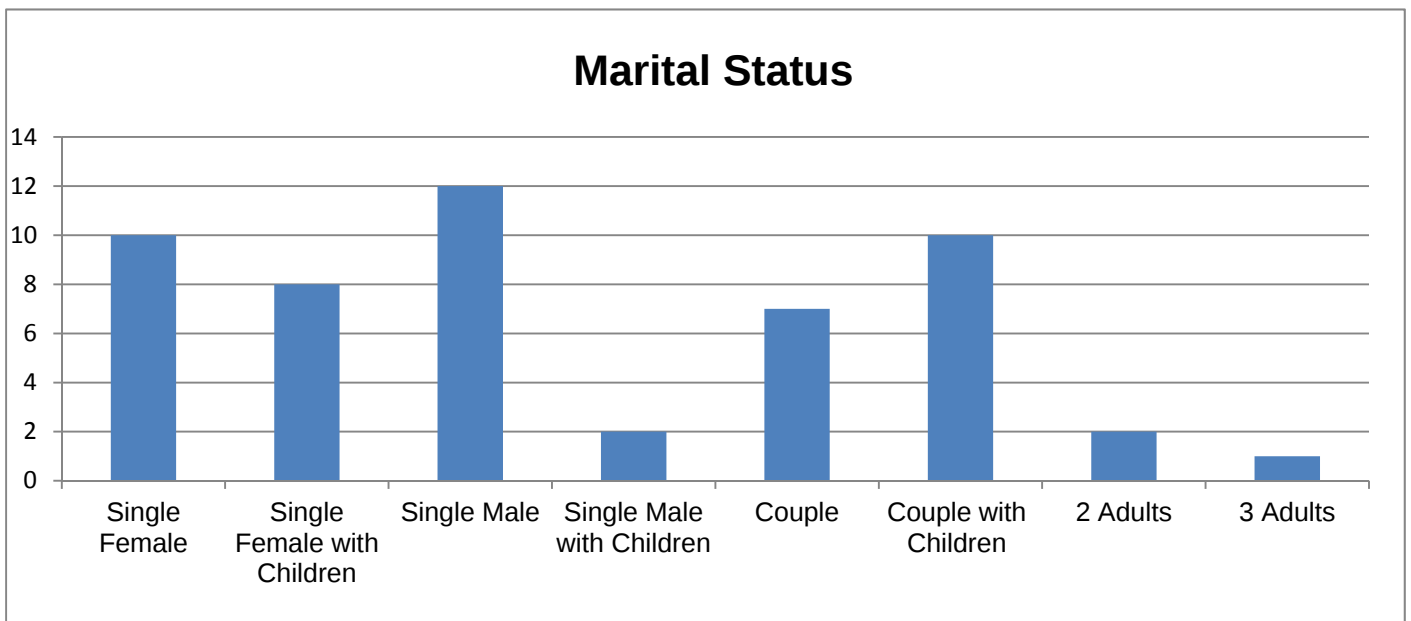
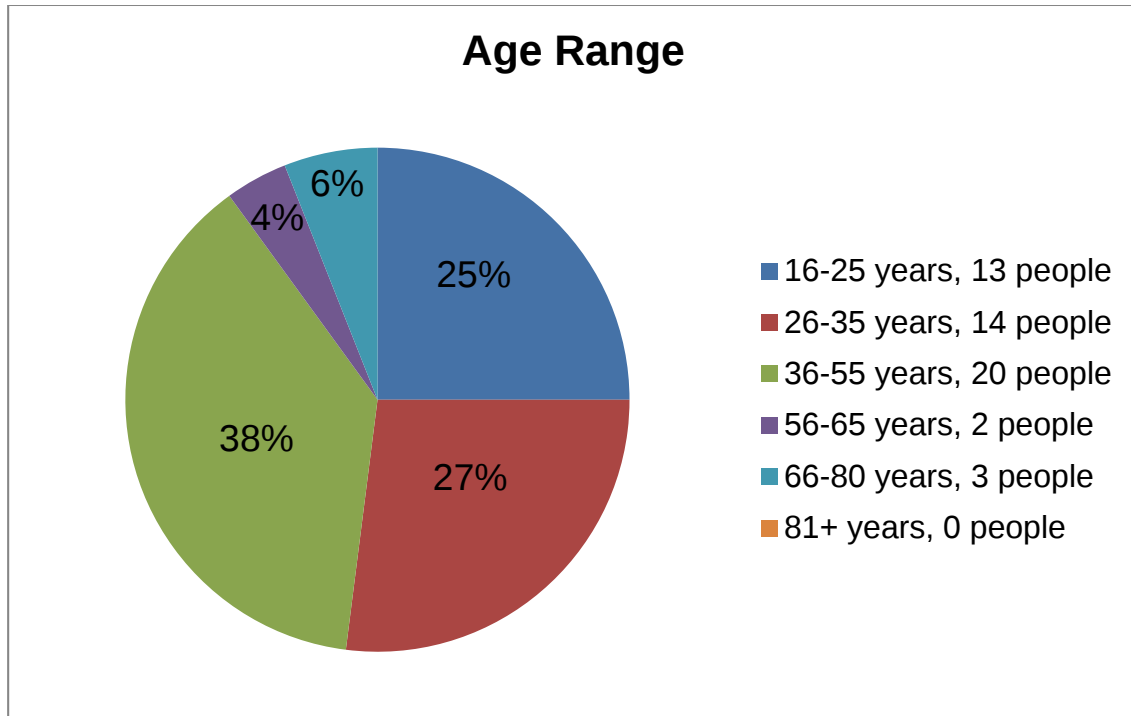


Who We Housed Year 2018/19

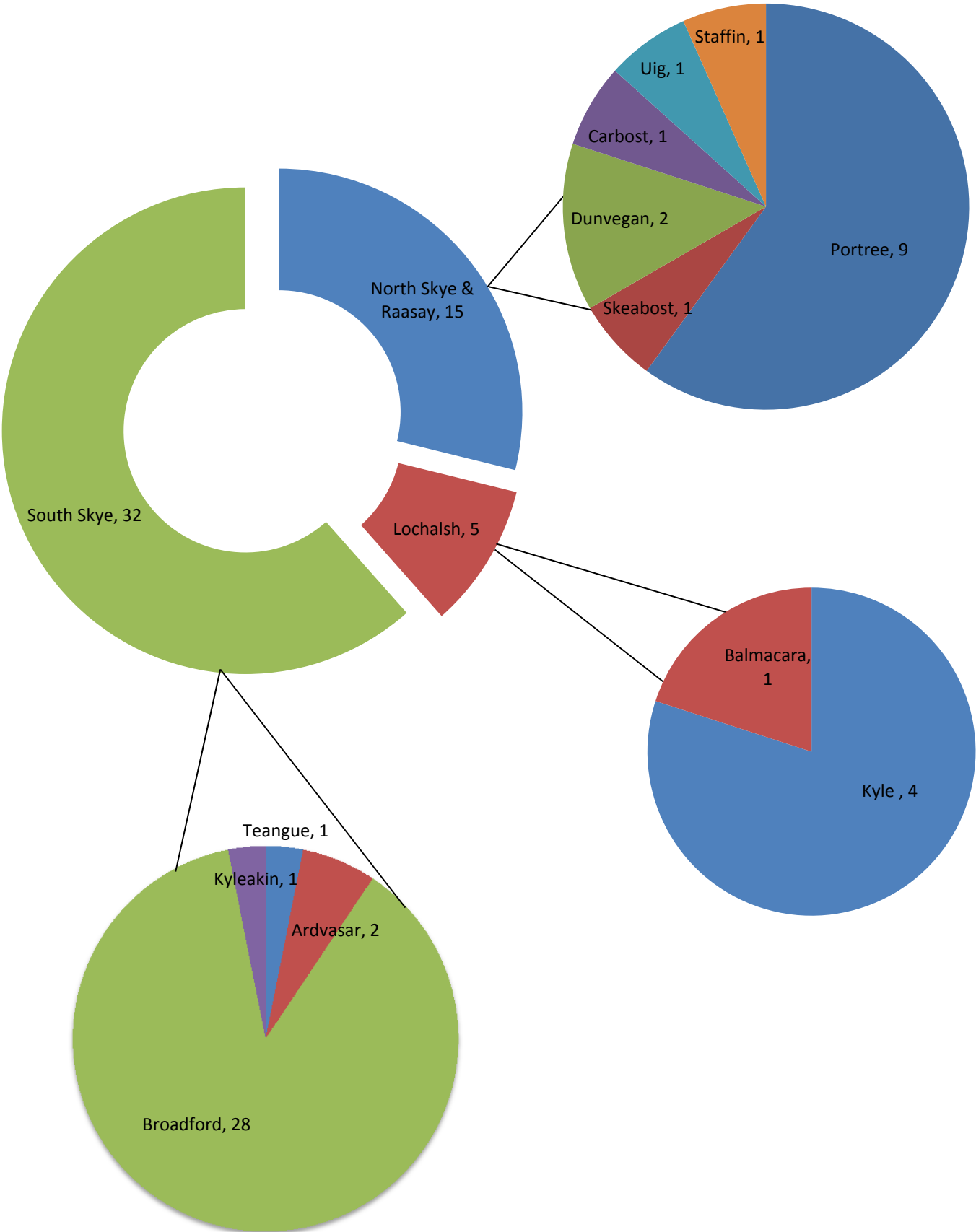
52 people housed – Not including mutual exchanges or lets to NHS or Council.



N.B – 2 or 3 Adults includes friends sharing a property or a parent with adult children

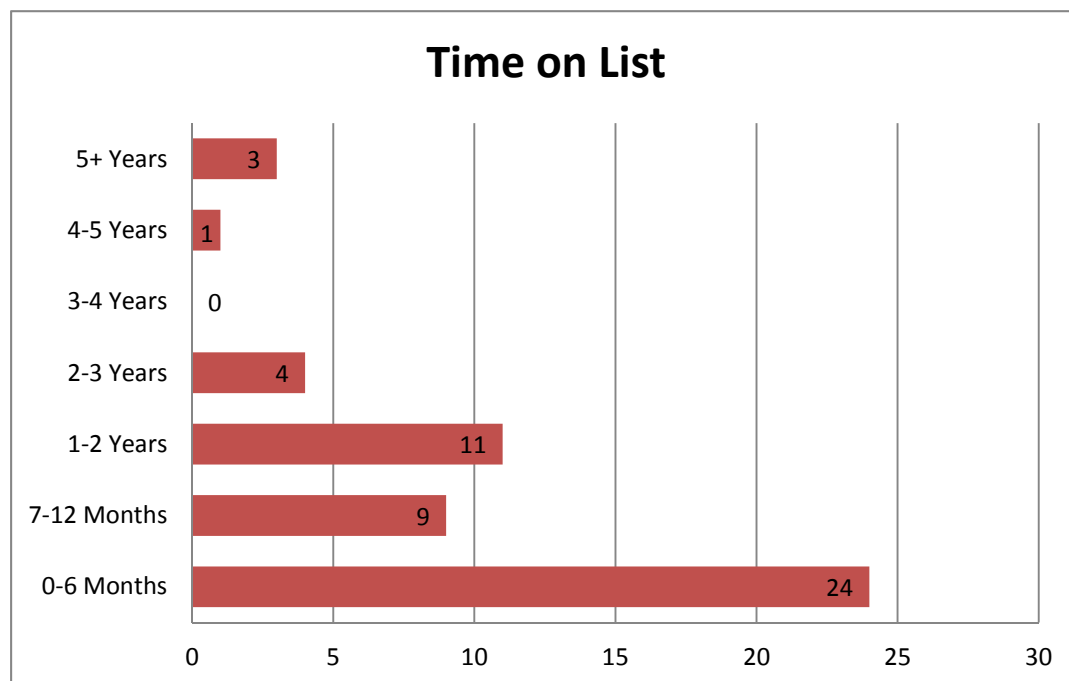
Area People Were Housed

A higher number of people housed in Broadford this year as there was the new development that was completed of 16 properties at Suisnish Place.

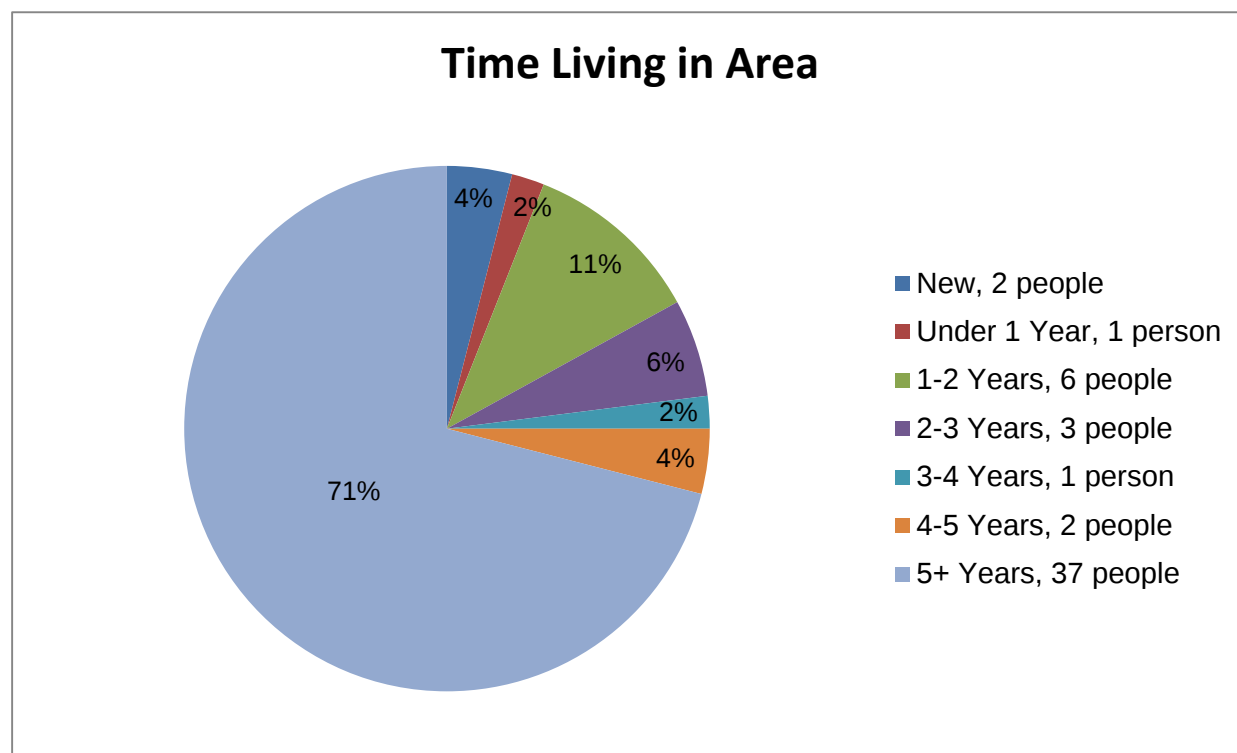


Time on Housing List

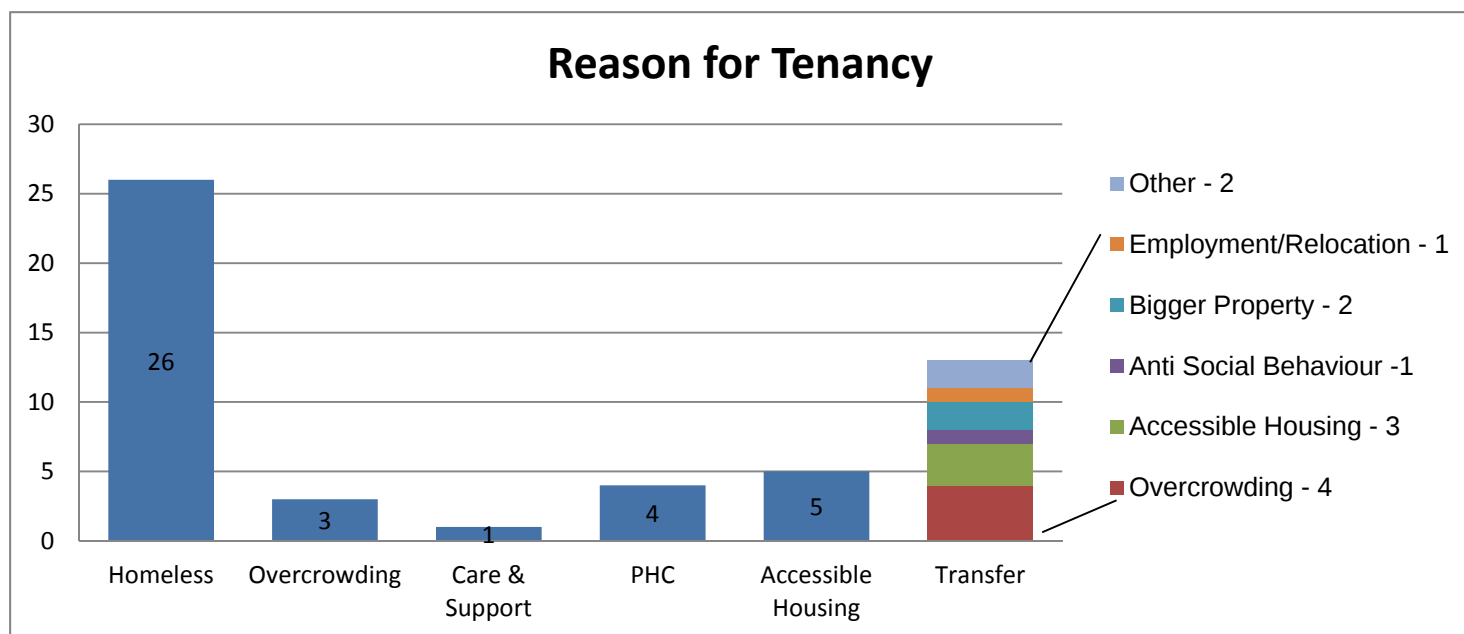
This has been calculated from the date the application was received at the holding office to the start date of the tenancy.

The amount of time lived in the Skye & Lochalsh area. 5+ years also includes people who have lived here all their lives. New means people who have not lived in the area previously



Homeless – been in temporary accommodation provided by the Council

Overcrowding – more people in the property than there is bed space

Care & Support – a young person in through care or someone who requires or needs to provide care & support for someone else

PHC (Poor Housing Conditions) – the condition of the property means the accommodation is not fit for habitation

Accessible Housing – is for someone who has a medical condition or disability that requires them to be housed in accommodation that enables them to carry out day to day tasks independently. This can be a specially adapted properties or a property closer to specialist services.

Transfer – Moving from one Housing Association or Council property to another.
